Be prepared during the first weeks of the school year to complete an assignment and engage in class discussions about *Wonder*. Reading or rereading this book close to the end of summer will keep it fresh in your memories.

Please keep a reading record sheet that includes titles and authors. This record should be signed by a parent and turned in to Mrs. Simons on the first day of school. An example reading log can be found here.
